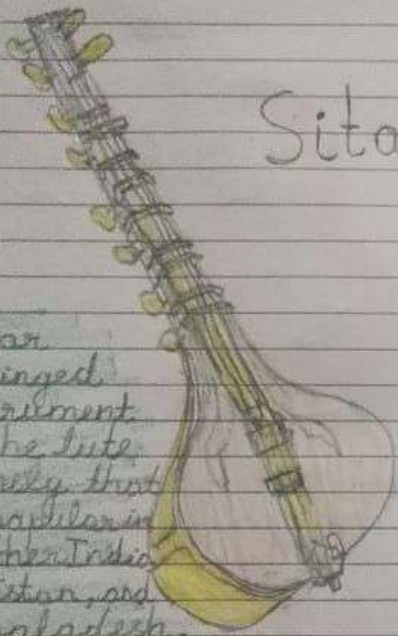


# Sitar

Sitar  
Stringed  
instrument

northern India,  
Pakistan, and  
Bangladesh.

Typically measuring about 1.2 metres  
(4 feet) in length the Sitar has a deep  
pear-shaped gourd body a long,  
wide, hollow wooden neck both  
front and side turning pegs and  
20 arched movable frets.

percussion instrument originating  
from the Indian Subcontinent  
consisting of a pair of drums,  
used in traditional, classical,  
popular and folk music....  
The name tabla likely comes from  
tabl, the Persian and Arabic word  
for drum

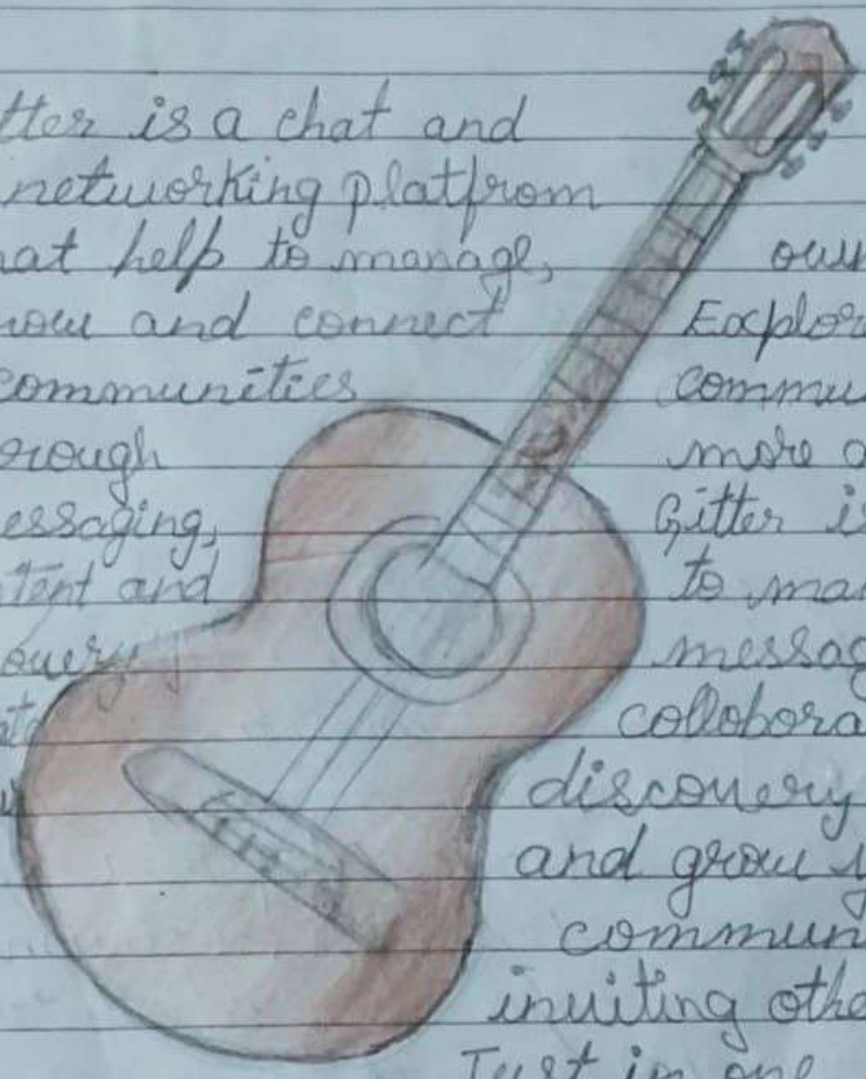

## Trumpet



The trumpet is a brass instrument commonly used in classical and jazz ensembles. The trumpet group ranges from the piccolo trumpet with the highest register in the brass family to the bass trumpet, which is pitched one octave below the standard B $\flat$  or C trumpet. The trumpet is characterized by its striking, triumphant sound and by the fact that it boasts the highest of all the brass instruments.

## Cymbals



A cymbal is a common percussion instrument. Often used in pairs, cymbals consist of thin, normally round plates of various alloys. The majority of cymbals are of indefinite pitch although small disc-shaped cymbals. A player of cymbals is known as a cymbalist.

## Drum



Drum, musical instrument, the sound of which is produced by the vibration of a stretched membrane (it is thus classified as a membranophone within the larger category of percussion instruments). Basically, a drum is either a tube or a bowl of wood, metal, or pot (the "shell") covered at one or both ends by a membrane (the "head"), which is usually struck by a bar or stick. Friction drums, a class apart are sounded by rubbing.



# Congo



The **Congo**, also known as tumbadora is a tall, single-headed drum from cuba. Congas are stored like barrels and classified into three types: quinto (lead drum highest), and tumba or salidor (lowest

Bell

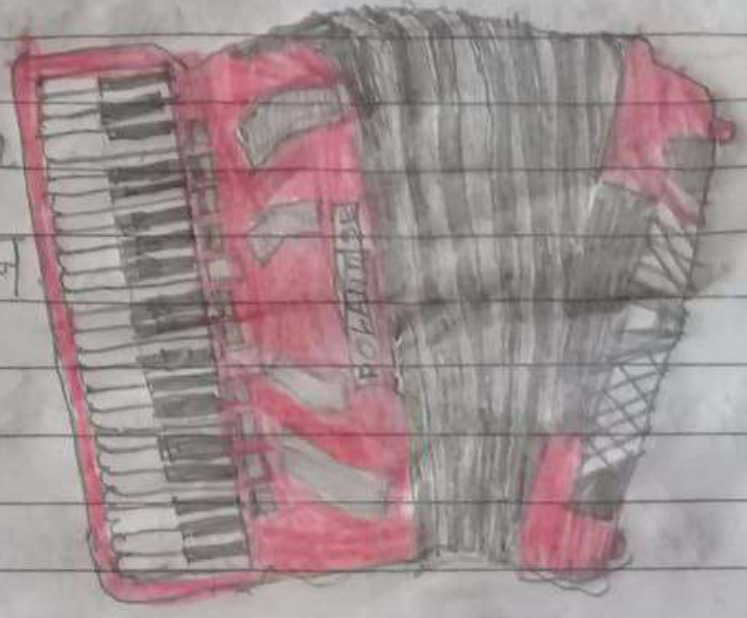
